WAIKOLOA, HI – More than 75 junior golfers paired up for the Hawaii State Junior Golf Association (HSJGA) Junior Tour Series at the Waikoloa Kings' and Beach Course this weekend for a two-day 36-hole tournament. The complete list of results is on the next page.

Waikoloa's junior golfers shined at the tournament with five youths placing within the top ten of their division. Tamara Surtees, 16, of Waikoloa won 1st place in the girls 15-18 division. Surtees recently won a sectional qualifier at Waikoloa Beach & Golf Resort to compete in the 2006 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship at Pumpkin Ridge Golf Club in Oregon.

Henry Park, 16, of Waikoloa won 1st place in the boys 15-18 division. Also placing 4th and 6th in the same division were Sean Maekawa of Paauilo and Max Bonk of Kamuela, respectively.

Ciera Min, 10, of Kamuela placed 3rd in the 10 & under girls division.

"We are all very proud of how Waikoloa's junior golfers played this weekend and it's a testament to the skills they've developed in our program," said Ross Birch, Waikoloa's head pro for the Kings' Course.

The Junior Tour Series is an ongoing series of golf tournaments held Statewide for Hawaii's junior golfers, ages 7-18. The winners of the series will be invited to participate in the 2006 Tournament of Champions in December.
